

Immediate Dentures Post-operative Instructions:

- 1. Do not remove dentures for 48 hours. The dentist should remove it only.
- 2. If the denture comes out, rinse it and place it back in your mouth.
- 3. Expect swelling and discomfort. Take pain medication as prescribed. Tylenol and Advil work well.
- 4. To decrease any swelling, apply ice packs 20 minutes on and 20 minutes off, for the first day immediately following your dental appointment.
- 5. Rest and quiet for the day of surgery are recommended.
- 6. Soft diet for 2-3 days is recommended, i.e., fruit shakes, yogurt, soup, mashed potatoes, pasta, scrambled eggs etc....
- 7. Warm salt water rinses starting tomorrow. Do not remove dentures when rinsing your mouth.
